Level 2


Level Two is the interventional floor, where most procedures likely to require a hospital stay of some hours or days are done.

The northwest corner is taken up by our Surgical Program. From pre-op to recovery, it all happens here. On the northeast side are our Angiography and Interventional Radiology Suites. Adjacent to them is our Laboratory equipped with some of the latest in specimen testing technology.

Towards the south side is the Diagnostic Imaging Program - MRI, CT, X-ray and Ultrasound - and our Breast Health Centre.

With Medical Daycare (short-term recovery) and some procedures that require anaesthesia - Endoscopy and Cystoscopy - rounding out the floor, the natural patient flow is efficient and comfortable.

A staircase from the main portals of care entrances and three banks of public elevators provide easy access to this floor. This level also receives lots of natural light thanks to the two-storey grand hallway that this floor overlooks on the south side.



Level 3

The main administrative, informational and educational areas of the new hospital are on Level Three. The executive offices for both hospital and medical staff administration are located on this floor.

Recognizing our expanding role in medical education, medical staff workspaces, meeting rooms, a lounge and on-call sleep rooms are located on this floor. The auditorium and classrooms provide space for staff and physician education, and for hospital events.

Humber's Information Systems team is on this floor, and our ICAT (Information, Communications and Technology) systems all run through here. Adjacent to them is where Clinical Informatics and Health Records are located.

With our implementation of an Electronic Health Record (EHR), these play a critical role in keeping our online EHR populated with the most current care data and clinical process information modules.

Rounding out this level are two groups vital to our efforts to be truly patient-centred: our Volunteers and our Chaplains.
